How To Turn On Bluetooth On The Tablet When Docked

In this section, we will explain how to Pair the Phoenix game controllers to your Vizualogic[®] Tablet when docked in the vehicles Headrest.

- 1. Make sure the Tablet is docked into the Headrest and the vehicles power is on.
- 2. Go to the Tablets Home Screen. (Fig 1)
- 3. Select the Apps icon in the upper left hand corner of the Tablets Home Screen. (Fig 1)
- 4. When the Apps drawer opens swipe from the right side of the Tablet screen to the left side, to get to the 2nd Apps page. (Fig 2)
- 5. Select the Settings icon. (Fig 3)
- 6. Locate the Bluetooth icon, and press it to open the Bluetooth Settings. (Fig 4)
- 7. Turn On the Bluetooth by pressing the Off icon. (Fig 5)
- 8. Bluetooth icon should change from Off to On. (Fig 6)



How To Turn On The Pairing For The Phoenix Controllers



- 1. Press the X button on the Phoenix ONE / Phoenix MINI game controller, and the Pair/Home button at the same time.
- 2. Once these buttons are pressed you should see the LED light start to flash rapidly.
- 3. Releast the 2 buttons.
- 4. Continued on next page.

How To Turn On Bluetooth On The Tablet When Undocked

In this section, we will explain how to Pair the Phoenix ONE game controller to your Vizualogic[®] Tablet when not docked in the vehicles Headrest.

- 1. Make sure the Tablet is powered on.
- 2. Go to the Tablets Home Screen. (Fig 1)
- 3. Select the Apps icon located in the center right of the Tablets Home Screen. (Fig 1)
- 4. When the Apps drawer opens swipe from the right side of the Tablet screen to the left side, to get to the 2nd Apps page. (Fig 2)
- 5. Select the Settings icon. (Fig 3)
- 6. Locate the Bluetooth icon, and press it to open the Bluetooth Settings. (Fig 4)
- 7. Turn On the Bluetooth by pressing the Off icon. (Fig 5)
- 8. Bluetooth icon should change from Off to On. (Fig 6)
